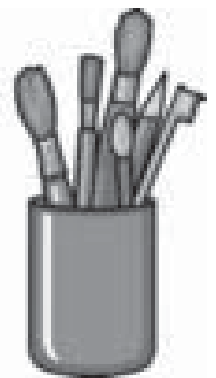

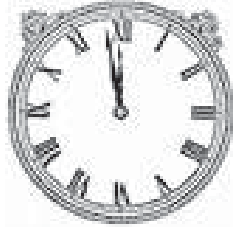

Teen Summer Studios

Teens (middle school and high school) have Summer Studios space with classes aimed to reach their interests from 6:30- 8:30 p.m. Classes run 6 weeks. All supplies are included.

Wednesdays • July 11 - August 15 Drawing & Airbrush Techniques

This studio session will focus on character development utilized in cartooning and comic images.
